COURSE OVERVIEW

The Diploma in Ministry equips students with foundational knowledge and skills to engage in practical Christian ministry in a range of contexts. It explores the biblical and theological basis of ministry, and assists students to utilise tools of personal and theological reflection to understand themselves in relation to their ministry contexts, grow their capacity and respond effectively to their call to praise God and serve people.

This qualification will be offered through ALC's distributed learning model, allowing individuals to engage with subjects, lecturers and fellow students through online communities and put their learning into practice through local engagement. This qualification can compliment the Discover program.

COURSE OUTCOMES

Graduates from the Diploma in Ministry program showcase a strong grasp of Christian texts and traditions that relate to personal development and ministry with others, the capacity to apply foundational ministry knowledge and skills in responsive ways to ministry contexts and also learn exceptional interpersonal and teamwork skills.

Additionally graduates will gain opportunities to reflect theologically on their ministry practice.
