# Chamber Organ Enquire today!

Due to the sale of ALC's North Adelaide campus, the chamber organ, currently located in the College chapel, requires a new home.

The organ was donated to the College by organ builder Daniel Bittner, and thanks to funds raised by several congregations and members of the LCA, it underwent improvements prior to being installed in 2017.

Ideally the College would like to see the organ rehoused within the Lutheran community.

#### **Details of instrument**

The organ is a three-rank unit instrument, built in visually striking open placement style, where all speaking pipes are displayed in two opposite parabola formations.

The instrument measures 2.5 metres wide x 2.1 metres deep and 3.375 metres high and requires normal 240-volt power (not 3-phase). A 3-drawer mobile storage unit for music is included.

The instrument will be moved and reinstalled by Richard Larritt Organ Builders. The ideal time for this move is March/April 2025 but this can be varied by negotiation. It must, however, be removed from ALC no later than the end of May 2025.
