It engages participants in introductory biblical and theological study, as well as a study consideration of identity and pedagogy of Lutheran education.

The Lutheran Strand is available to both undergraduate and graduate levels.

PROGRAM UNITS

Undergraduate students enrol in a Certificate in Divinity, Postgraduate students in a Graduate Certificate in Teaching Religious Education.

There are four units:

- A biblical unit
- A theological unit
- A unit related to the history and identity of Lutheran Education
- A unit relating to pedagogy in Christian Studies and leading school worship
