### Commentary on tuition fees

- All fees listed are quoted in Australian dollars (AUD\$). Fees are subject to change from year to year.
- Tuition fees are payable upfront at the time of enrolment or through FEE-HELP assistance. All tuition fees are to be paid prior to the commencement of the unit. Overseas students must pay tuition fees two weeks before the start of the semester.
- FEE-HELP assistance for tuition fee payment is available, on application, to eligible domestic students for accredited units of study. See <http://studyassist.gov.au> for eligibility requirements.
- Audit fees cannot be paid through FEE-HELP.
- *Tuition fees are not refundable for students withdrawing after the census date.* (See *UD Census Date Information* at [key dates](#) for additional details.)
- In special circumstances, it may be possible for an enrolled student to withdraw from a unit of study after the census date of the unit and receive a refund of fees or recredit of a FEE-HELP balance. See <https://divinity.edu.au/study/fees/late-withdrawal-protocol/>. If unforeseen circumstances occur, please contact the Dean to discuss your enrolment and/or refund options.
- Master's degree by research: major thesis candidates complete the course over 3 semesters (full-time). Continuing students enrolled in the minor thesis complete 2 units plus minor thesis over 3 semesters (full-time). The actual total amount may vary as fees change each year.

- The University unit point system is:
  - a standard undergraduate unit is 18 points;
  - a standard postgraduate unit is 24 points.
 Typical postgraduate units offered by ALC include units with point values of 4, 8, 12, 16, 24 or 48.
- Graduate Certificate in Theological Education fees are reduced by 20% for University of Divinity staff.
