

Student representatives on ALC committees

Purpose

Student representatives represent the views, opinions and concerns of the student body as appropriate to the Australian Lutheran College (ALC) committees to which they are elected, and report the relevant outcomes or deliberations to the student body.

Student representative elections

Student representatives on ALC committees are elected annually by the processes outlined by the ALC Student Representative Association (ASRA) constitution. Names of the student representatives are notified by ASRA to the Office of Dean (OD as soon as possible after election). The OD notifies chairs of the relevant committees and the Principal.

Responsibilities

Student representatives are to attend all required meetings of the respective committees unless an apology has been given beforehand. Attendance of proxy representatives may also be negotiated with the committee chair.

The student representatives report back to the student body as outlined in the ASRA constitution.

The student representatives hold office for the duration of term of their election.

Committees

Student representatives are nominated for the following ALC committees:

- Leadership Team (The ASRA chair-person will represent the students on this committee.)
- Education Staff Meeting
- Academic Committee (The student representative must be in at least their third year at ALC.)
- Women's Auxiliary

Committee descriptors

Leadership Team

The Leadership Team assists the Principal in the strategic direction of the college and oversight operations.

Education Staff Meeting

The Education Staff Meeting works together with the Associate Dean for Learning and Teaching to advise and make proposals to the Academic Committee on strategies, initiatives and innovations that support the highest standards in learning and teaching, research and research training, vocational training, community engagement and scholarship.

Academic Committee

The Academic Committee works together with the Dean on academic issues and matters to meet the University of Divinity and ALC Board requirements.

Women's Auxiliary

The Women's Auxiliary supports student life at ALC on behalf of Lutheran Women of Australia.
